

1 Alps - 475 Yards.
Uphill approach, a long drive is required to carry the bunker at corner of dogleg with punch bowl inspired green.

2 Garden - 424 Yards.
Downhill hole with elevated green protected by bunkering front right. Honoring NJ "Garden State".

3 Banks - 185 Yards.
Elevated green with bunkering at front left with mid-length one shot hole.

4 Reverse Redan - 495 Yards.
Reminiscent of the 14th at St. Andrews reverse redan green complex.

5 Swilken - 478 Yards. A drainage ditch running across several holes is reminiscent of the burns found in Scotland.
Decisions, decisions, decisions... lay back or attempt to carry it off the tee.

6 Short - 162 Yards.
This hole puts iron accuracy, distance control and a deft putting touch at a premium.

7 Burn - 420 Yards.
The burn comes into play for longer hitters providing a strategic decision off the tee.

8 Redan - 190 Yards.
A large green with slope and contour running away from the front, putting a premium on judging distance.

9 Double Plateau - 374 Yards.
Similar to double plateau greens with gentler slopes than other renditions of this template hole.

RULES

1. USGA rules govern play.
2. Soft spikes only.
3. Please observe 90° cart rule.
4. Please keep carts on the paths around tees and greens.
5. All yardages are to the center of the green.
6. Collared shirts must be worn at all times.
7. Each player must have their own set of clubs.
8. All fences on course are out of bounds. Local Rule played as 1 stroke penalty from point of exit.

ETIQUETTE

1. Please repair ball marks, replace divots and leave rakes in bunker when finished.
2. Please keep pace with the group in front of you.
3. Please play from the appropriate tees.


Rail "Road" - 575 Yards.



Fairway bunker at right on ideal line. Railroad track in play resembling strategy of road hole at St. Andrews.



Wee Biarritz - 154 Yards.
Scaled down version of the traditional Biarritz template hole.

Sakura - 336 Yards.
Named in honor of the Japanese cherry blossoms at Branch Brook Park bordering this hole.

Essex - 210 Yards. Original green from Banks layout converted from par four into the longest one-shot hole on the course.

Principal's Nose - 372 Yards.
Defining feature set in right center of fairway at location of ideal drive or to be carried with second shot.

Cape - 335 Yards.
Similar but less severe version of 2nd at Yale, with cape green jutting out over bunker.

Eden - 162 Yards.
A challenging green that is well protected by bunker on right.

Long Drive Home - 445 Yards. Requires big hit off tee, and most times an accurate long iron shot to a well protected green.
