This summer, the Essex County Parks Archives presented an exhibit to commemorate Weequahic Golf Course's 100th Anniversary. Weequahic Golf Course was the first public golf course in New Jersey.

The first display case highlights the development of Essex County's public golf. The second display case explores the experience of public golf in the county. The framed collages celebrate the people who have been a part of the Weequahic Golf Course. The mannequin represents typical golf attire worn in the early 20th century.
